Breckenridge

Nova Guides will provide curb side pickup at Breckenridge lodges for guests that book 6 or more paying adults for a Guided Tour. All Breckenridge pickups will be 1 hour before the listed pickup times of that tour's description. Drop offs will be 1 hour after posted return time.

Pickup provided to guests that book 6 or more paying adults for a Guided Tour. The Frisco Transportation Center is conveniently located behind the Frisco Wal-Mart. All Frisco pickups will be 45 minutes before the listed pickup times of that tour's description. Drop offs will be 45 minutes after posted return time.

Copper Mountain

Pickup provided to guests that book 6 or more paying adults for a Guided Tour. Guests will be picked up and dropped off at the Copper Mountain Lodging Check-In Center. All Copper Mountain pickups will be 30 minutes before the listed pickup times of that tour's description. Drop offs will be 30 minutes after posted return time.

Traveling to Nova Guides from Vail/Minturn

Travel over famous Vail Pass on I-70, past the Town of Vail, then to exit 171, go right on Highway 24 south. 14 miles to our Camp Hale Nova Guides lodge.

Traveling to Nova Guides from Summit County & Leadville

I-70 at Copper Mountain, travel scenic Highway 91, visit 10,152ft Leadville, then Hwy 24 north to historical Camp Hale Nova Guides lodge. Nova Guides will be on right side of road, 14 miles north along Hwy 24.
